Dear Robert,

We and are pleased to tell you that we have considered your application and are now in a position to make you the following offer of tools and equipment for your project. All the tools and equipment offered are second hand refurbished items and are a free gift from Christians in UK and therefore comes to you as a gift. However we do ask that you contribute towards the cost of shipment from UK to arrival at our warehouse in Kampala, Uganda, from where you would be responsible for collecting the shipment or arranging for delivery to your project. You would also be responsible for the Ugandan Customs Charges and any duty levied by them on the shipment. Duties must be paid and the goods collected from our warehouse within 30 days from you being notified of their arrival and the amount you have to pay. If the money is not paid and they are not collected within 60 days we have the right to dispose of the goods elsewhere.

Before we are able to ship the goods to you we will need to have the shipment cost deposited in our Bank Account in Uganda. Our bank details are as below:-

1 Cubic Metre of School Educational Books for each of the three schools listed in your application, plus TWAM Scholar Packs.

Shipment cost Ex UK to arrival our Kampala Warehouse £255 - 00 Pounds Sterling.

Because of the fluctuating exchange rates, if you wish to make a payment for these goods in Uganda Shillings as listed above then contact our Uganda Office, who will advise you the current price in Uganda Shillings to enable you to pay the money into our account.

The ban on shipment of Computers to Uganda came into effect 31<sup>st</sup> March 2010, we are therefore unable to offer second hand computers at the present time. Future shipment will be conditional upon the Ugandan Government either removing or extending its ban.

We would ask that you read our attachment detailing what we expect of our Vocational Training Partners. In return for complying with our outlined programme they will be given priority status on future applications. Please discuss questions with our Uganda Representative, Robert Tumuhairwe who will be willing to share with you our vision for effective Vocational Training.

Shipping cost will need to be deposited into our bank account before we can reserve shipping space for you. When payment has been made please notify me, and, also our Uganda Office This will enable us to reserve the space for you in the next available container which we anticipate will be in November 2011. All containers up to that period are now full.
